The Objectives of this activity are to:

1. Present a class of sheep in the most attractive manner. Contestant may lead either a wether, a market lamb, or a registered ewe.
2. Give spectators an opportunity to view young people modeling wool garments while leading the wool producer.
3. The following standards will be used when judging the classes:
 - A. Entrant's garment (suitable & practical for contestant's maturity, etc.)
 - B. Poise & appearance (Accessories, make-up, etc. appropriate for entrant's maturity, and to style of garment. Entrant appears to be at ease and wears garment to best advantage.)
 - C. Control and presentation of sheep
4. Entries may be obtained from the Fair Office or www.appalachianfair.com and should be returned to the Appalachian Fair. Entry will contain brief biography of entrant and garment description. Entry forms must be returned by August 5th.
5. Contestants should report to the Show Pavilion for rehearsal at 6:00 p.m. Friday evening, August 24th.
