### FAIREST OF THE FAIR CONTEST

**Deadline: AUGUST 4, 2011**

This contest is held in conjunction with Tennessee's "Fairest of the Fair" Contest, which is sponsored by the Tennessee Association of Fairs. The Appalachian Fair and any Civic Organization or Business Firm will sponsor this event.

#### RULES

1. A \$50.00 NON-REFUNDABLE ENTRY FEE IS REQUIRED FOR EACH CONTESTANT. Contestant must be sponsored by a Civic Organization or Business Firm.
2. Contestant must have reached her 16<sup>th</sup> birthday, but not her 21<sup>st</sup> birthday on/or before December 31 of the year in which the contest is held and must be a resident of Tennessee. Original birth certificate must be presented at the first rehearsal.
3. Contestant cannot qualify if she has ever been married, had a child, competed in the last state contest, or found guilty of a felony. She must be of good moral character, and is now, and has always been, a female.
4. Costume must be formal and must be floor length. No exposed midriff. Contestants will not be allowed to wear or carry live flowers during the judging.
5. Contestants will be judged on beauty, poise, and personality.
6. Entry may be made by completing an entry form obtained from the Appalachian Fair office, downloading from internet, calling 477-3211, or e-mail request to – [appfair@embarqmail.com](mailto:appfair@embarqmail.com). The form should be returned to the fair office on or before AUGUST 4<sup>TH</sup> with a \$50 non-refundable entry fee. Form may be mailed to the Appalachian Fair P. O. Box 8218, Gray, TN 37615. The Appalachian Fair reserves the right to limit the number of contestants to 30, however, no entries or fees will be accepted after August 4<sup>th</sup>. Checks should be made out to the Appalachian Fair. Credit Cards accepted are VISA, MASTERCARD or DISCOVER.
7. Contest will be held at the Appalachian Fairgrounds on Monday night, August 22<sup>nd</sup>, at 8:00 p.m. at the Museum Stage.
8. In consideration of accepting this entry, I, the undersigned hereby for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, waive and release any and all claims for personal injury or property damage, of whatever form and nature, I may have against the Appalachian Fair, the pageant director, or any named sponsor, that may arise from participation in this contest.

#### AWARD
