This contest is held in conjunction with Tennessee's "Fairest of the Fair" Contest, which is sponsored by the Tennessee Association of Fairs. The Appalachian Fair and their supporters will sponsor this event.

RULES

MUST BE AVAILABLE THE WEEK OF THE FAIR TO FULFILL REQUESTED DUTIES

- 1. A \$50.00 NON-REFUNDABLE ENTRY FEE IS REQUIRED FOR EACH CONTESTANT. Contestant must be sponsored by a Civic Organization or Business Firm.
- 2. Contestant must have reached her 16th birthday, but not her 21st birthday on/or before December 31 of the year in which the contest is held and must be a resident of Tennessee. Original birth certificate must be presented at the first rehearsal.
- 3. Contestant cannot qualify if she has ever been married, had a child, competed in the last state contest, or found guilty of a felony. She must be of good moral character, and is now, and has always been, a female. If the winner of the Appalachian Fair Pageant wins another title during her reign, that prevents her from wearing the Appalachian Fair crown and sash, she must relinquish her crown and scholarship.
- 4. Costume must be formal and must be floor length. No exposed midriff. Contestants will not be allowed to wear or carry live flowers during the judging.
- 5. Contestants will be judged on beauty, poise, and personality.
- 6. Entry may be made by completing an entry form Forms may be obtained directly from the Appalachian Fair office, on their website at www.appalachianfair.com, by calling 423-477-3211, or through e-mail request to appfair@embarqmail.com. The form should be returned to the fair office on or before AUGUST 13th with a \$50 non-refundable entry fee. Forms may be returned to the Appalachian Fair directly, by mail: PO Box 8218, Gray, TN 37615, by fax: 423-477-3853 or e-mailed: appfair@embarqmail.com. If faxed or e-mailed, the fee must be paid by credit card. An online payable invoice may be requested if you do not wish to fax or email your credit card information. The Appalachian Fair reserves the right to limit the number of contestants to 30, however, no entries or fees will be accepted after August 13th. Checks should be made out to the Appalachian Fair. All major credit cards are accepted.
- 7. Contest will be held at the Appalachian Fairgrounds on Monday night, August 24th, at 7:30 PM on the Museum Stage.
- 8. In consideration of accepting this entry, I, the undersigned hereby for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, waive and release any and all claims for personal injury or property damage, of whatever form and nature, I may have against the Appalachian Fair, the pageant director, or any named sponsor, that may arise from participation in this contest.

AWARD

- 1. The young lady who receives the title of Appalachian Fair's "Fairest of the Fair" will receive a \$2,500.00 scholarship award when she returns to crown the winner the following year. She must show proof that she is registered at a recognized college, university, or vocational school and submit receipts or proof of registration to the Appalachian Fair. The final decision on this situation will be at the discretion of the Appalachian Fair. The winner will represent the Appalachian Fair in Tennessee's "Fairest of the Fair" contest in Murfreesboro in January 2021. The Appalachian Fair will reimburse the actual expenses of the queen and her chaperone to the State Contest.
- 2. The winner of the State-wide contest will receive the title of "Tennessee's Fairest of the Fairs", and such prizes as approved by the Tennessee Association of Fairs.
