1. The number one objective of this activity is to present a class of sheep in the most attractive manner. Contestant may lead either a wether, a market lamb, or a registered ewe.
2. The second objective is to give spectators an opportunity to view individuals modeling wool garments while leading the wool producer.
3. The following standards will be used when judging the classes:
 - A. Entrant's garment (suitable & practical for contestant's maturity, etc.)
 - B. Poise & appearance (Accessories, make-up, etc. appropriate for entrant's maturity, and to style of garment. Entrant appears to be at ease and wears garment to best advantage.)
 - C. Control and presentation of sheep
4. Entry will contain brief biography of entrant and garment description.
5. Entry Forms may be obtained from the Appalachian Fair Office and returned to the Fair Office. **Entry forms requested by August 14th.**
6. Contestants should report to the Show Pavilion for rehearsal at 6 pm, Friday evening, August 28th.

LOT 2 - Junior contestants -- 8 through 11 years of age

LOT 3 - Intermediate contestants -- 12 through 15 years of age

LOT 4 - Senior contestants -- 16 through 20 years of age
