The Objectives of this activity are to:

1. Present a class of sheep in the most attractive manner. Contestant may lead either a wether, a market lamb, or a registered ewe.
2. Give spectators an opportunity to view young people modeling wool garments while leading the wool producer.
3. The following standards will be used when judging the classes:
 - A. Entrant's garment (suitable & practical for contestant's maturity, etc.)
 - B. Poise & appearance (Accessories, make-up, etc. appropriate for entrant's maturity, and to style of garment. Entrant appears to be at ease and wears garment to best advantage.)
 - C. Control and presentation of sheep
4. Entry will contain brief biography of entrant and garment description.
5. Entries may be obtained from the Fair Office or downloaded at www.appalachianfair.com/contests and should be returned to the Appalachian Fair. **Entry forms requested by July 25th.**
6. Contestants should report to the Show Pavilion for rehearsal at 6:00 pm Friday evening, August 23rd.
