GRAY Community — Proud parents have been taking their young children to the Appalachian Fair for years to compete in the Annual Baby Show. The possibility of winning a class at the annual Baby Show is the draw for these proud parents and grandparents.

The Fair opens August 21 and plays through August 26.

The Baby Show will be held on Saturday, August 26 beginning at 9am. Winners not only get a ribbon, but a total of \$608 in premiums will be awarded.

No pre-registration for the Baby Show is required, but a \$10 entry fee is required at the time of registration. Those wishing to enter the judging contest should arrive 30 minutes prior to their class competition to register.

Babies, 6-12 months, will be judged on the Museum Stage beginning at 9am for girls and 10:30am for boys.

At 1pm, judging will begin for girls, 13-24 months. Boys in this age group will be judged at 2:30pm.

All Twins, ages 6-24months, will be judged beginning at 3:30pm.

In each age classification, awards will be made for the Best Developed Girl, Best Developed Boy, Prettiest Girl, Most Handsome Boy, Little Miss Personality, and Little Mr. Personality.
